Qualifications:

- Ability to interact and effectively communicate with culturally diverse, psychologically or behaviorally challenged population.
- Assertive, self-confident, and sensitive in working with teens and staff.
- Organized and dependable.
- Possess a valid driver's license and a good driving record without restrictions, except for glasses.
- Demonstrate spiritual, social, emotional, and intellectual maturity.
- Solid family orientation on which to draw when modeling this value to the clients a plus.

This person will need to be responsible, dependable and flexible with the residents. This person will need to use authority, but also much understanding and love.

The primary teacher will have a heart for the Agape ministry. Coming alongside teens from hard places, the ideal candidate will be able to problem solve with students in the moment and come alongside of them as emotional and behavioral concerns arise in order to help them overcome academic barriers. Beginning each morning out with devotions, the teacher will help the students transition into their core academic classes.

While students are self-paced with their learning, some may require one to one instruction. Guidance towards credit recovery, testing assistance, academic readiness and overseeing current curriculum will be essential keys to this position.
