Job Summary: The Resident Assistant (RA) is a full-time ministry position at an all girls' or boys' home. The RA must be a younger person who will come alongside the girls or boys as a mentor/life skills coach, offering the love of the Lord and supporting the teenagers' needs to help them overcome the hurts from their past. We are relationship oriented, starting with our relationship with the Lord, and including with staff and our clients. The RA will work closely with the House Staff to ensure that the home for the girls or boys who reside there is run efficiently and lovingly. Key requirement is love and compassion for hurting teens. This position includes room and board as part of the compensation package. This position begins at the end of August and goes through June.
